

Hazelwood Middle School Intramural Philosophy

The philosophy of the Hazelwood Middle School Intramural program is that each student should have the opportunity to participate in recreational activities. The program is designed to attract the maximum amount of students; this is achieved by offering a variety of games and activities. These activities and games can be competitive and non-competitive.

Intramural Program Information

Intramural sessions will be held on scheduled afternoons from 3:45 pm until 4:45 pm in the gym. Any student who comes to the gym after 3:55 pm will not be allowed to participate on that day since activities and teams will already be established for the day's session. Students will not be required to change clothes for intramurals. However, all participants must wear tennis shoes. If a student needs to change clothes either before or after participation, he or she will be allowed to change in the gym locker rooms. Students will sign in at the gym each afternoon so that attendance can be tracked. All students in attendance at an intramural session must be active participants except in the case of special events or game or activity spectators. AT NO TIME is a student to leave the gym without first asking the teacher in charge! Students will use the restrooms and water fountains located in the gym only. All students are to remain in the gym for the duration of the intramural sessions.

Behavior Expectations

Students are expected to act in an appropriate manner before, during, and after intramural sessions. In order to fulfill our philosophy of having the maximum number of participants enjoy success in recreational activities we must create and adhere to general behavior guidelines for all intramural participants.

1. Students will have the opportunity to participate in any scheduled activity, regardless of skill level.
2. Students will be able to choose their own teams and play grade appropriate opponents in various games and activity.
3. Students will wait for the supervising teacher to take equipment out of the equipment room. Students will help set up and put equipment away when necessary.
4. Students will display appropriate cooperation and sportsmanship at all times.
5. All school rules will be in effect during any intramural activity.

We would like to encourage your child to become involved in the Hazelwood Middle School intramural program. The purpose of intramurals is to provide students the opportunity to participate in a variety of recreational activities after school.

Participation in intramurals will not only provide a chance for your child to improve his or her sport skills, but will also give the student ample opportunities to make new friends and demonstrate such qualities as sportsmanship, cooperation, and leadership in a supervised and structured environment.

The Hazelwood Middle School intramural program will begin at 3:45 pm in the gym and end at 4:45 pm. Students wishing to participate must report to the gym by 3:55. No student will be allowed to participate in that day's activities if he/she arrives after 3:55 pm, unless they have been with a teacher and have obtained a pass from that teacher.

Students will be required to sign in everyday they attend an intramural session. They are not required to change clothes, but we do ask that all participants wear court shoes or sneakers. Students will be allowed to use the locker rooms during intramurals. If it is necessary for a student to change clothes, he or she may do so in the locker rooms.

Appropriate behavior will be expected of all intramural participants and students may be removed from the program if poor behavior becomes a recurring problem.

The intramural coordinator hopes that you will encourage your child to participate frequently in the intramural program, as we feel that it is the perfect chance for our students to make friends, work on skills, and have fun at the end of the school day.
